BEN TANKARD

Ben Tankard is a painter living and working in the Blue Mountains. He worked for fifteen years in a bookstore, prior to becoming a full-time artist five years ago. Books and art have been life-long obsessions and Ben often combines the two.

The primary artistic inspiration for his works is twentieth century artist Jasper Johns, who took iconic images such as the American flag and recreated them as abstract paintings, rich with texture. Ben takes popular book covers and boardgames and recreates them on canvas in a dramatic way, with thick overlapping layers of paint, drips, splatters and splashes. This contest between the original clean designs and the expressionistic paintwork results in fresh, energetic works that also appeal to our sense of nostalgia.

Ben studied Fine Arts at the University of Western Sydney and has been a finalist in the Mosman Art Prize, Sulman Prize, Calleen Art Award and the Gallipoli Art Prize, and was the winner of the 2019 Hawkesbury Art Prize.

















Relocating to the Sydney suburb of Bronte in 2010, Melanie now paints full-time and focuses on the still life genre, which allows her to celebrate the beauty of Australian native flowers and everyday household items.

In May 2023, Melanie's work appeared on the cover of popular Australian magazine frankie. She has also been featured by Vogue Australia and appears in STILL LIFE, by author/curator Amber Creswell Bell, which was published by Thames & Hudson Australia in 2021 and features over 40 prominent Australian artists.

Melanie's work is held in private collections around Australia and in Denmark, Italy, France, Germany, London, Singapore and the US.











ZOE SERNACK

Zoe Sernack's imagined landscapes reflect the forms of nature above and below the surface, weaving together observation, memory and sensory experiences of place.

She holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts from The National Art School and has been a finalist in many Australian art prizes including Fisher's Ghost Award, Hornsby Art Award, Gosford Art Award, Into the Light Art Award and the Lethbridge 20000 Art Award.

She is a keen observer, often found sketching plants in Sydney gardens and parks. Working on timber boards, she uses a delicate colour palette, carving and textural mark-making to capture the rhythms of the Australian bush seen with the eyes and felt with the heart.

She has been exhibiting for 25 years with over 65 shows under her belt.



Phillip Edwards is an artist living and working in Bullarto Victoria











Buffalo Ramble 2018 Watercolor mixed media 115 x 90 cm








Subtle Tones of Being 2018 Watercolor mixed media 115 x 90 cm



Dull Lights Glow 2018 Watercolor mixed media 115 x 90 cm




Hidden Monolith 2019 Watercolor mixed media 115 x 90 cm




Everlasting Renewed Optimism 2022 Watercolor mixed media










Track View (Western Arthurs Range)2023






Golden Morning 2022 Watercolor mixed media 76 x 57cm
