SIDNEY TEODORUK

"Sidney Teodoruk is an artist of contrasts. Using every visual device at his disposal, he weaves strange narratives drenched in dichotomous imagery and text, then obscures large areas in swathes of block-colour, inviting the viewer to fill in the blanks.

Nostalgic, childhood objects are randomly scattered throughout fractured, neo-expressionist scapes, simultaneously evoking feelings of playfulness and unease." Words by Marissa Bagley

Teodoruk studied at the National Art School in Sydney and has exhibited widely in Australia, Hong Kong and London. A vibrant personality on the artscene he has been the subject of the Archibald on three separate occasions. His work is widely collected by art-lovers and celebrities including Anthony Kiedis from the Red Hot Chilli Peppers.

JAN SPENCER

Jan Spencer is a Sydney-based artist inspired by her cycling travels in Australia and abroad. Her intimate collage panels beam with intense colour, simplified form and cheerful energy.

During her travels Jan fills her handmade diaries with notes and sketches. Upon returning to her Rozelle studio she uses these initial sketches to render collages using luscious thick Caran d'Ache oil crayons on coloured papers. The final compositions are pasted on art board and sealed with varnish so the works require no framing or glass.

Jan has exhibited for over 30 years. Her work features in the Artbank Collection, The State Bank Collection and corporate and private collections in Australia, France, Japan, the USA and the UK.










Grasses 2023 Oil crayon and paper collage on board 25 x 20cm




Wetland 2023 Oil crayon and paper collage on board 25 x 20cm





Working purely from memory, rather than from photos or real life, Darren allows the extraneous details of the landscape to fall away focusing his attention on the story of a place and moment. The landscapes are simplified, partly abstracted, balanced and soothing

Darren primarily uses acrylics and oil sticks on canvas and works from his home studio in Peregian Beach, Queensland.







Zoe Sernack's imagined landscapes reflect the forms of nature above and below the surface, weaving together observation, memory and sensory experiences of place.


She holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts from The National Art School and has been a finalist in many Australian art prizes including Fisher's Ghost Award, Hornsby Art Award, Gosford Art Award, Into the Light Art Award and the Lethbridge 20000 Art Award.

She is a keen observer, often found sketching plants in Sydney gardens and parks. Working on timber boards, she uses a delicate colour palette, carving and textural mark-making to capture the rhythms of the Australian bush seen with the eyes and felt with the heart.

She has been exhibiting for 25 years with over 65 shows under her belt.





Liew worked with the New Dance Theatre in the mid- 1970s and won the 'Sydney Morning Herald' Art Scholarship in 1981. He has exhibited in Sydney since 1972 and his work is represented in institutional and private collections in Australia and overseas.
